It will be a monthly celebration of feminine strength, skill, and ambition, running throughout the year, transforming football into a pathway towards improved livelihoods.

We are calling on you to help us mobilize young village women, equipping them with not only the gear for the game but also the tools for life. With improved training and life skills development, we believe that every kick of the ball, every goal scored, will be a step towards gender equality and women empowerment in Mpigi communities.

Through the Yamba Hearts Women's Football tournament, we will support local community girls' football teams with:

- High-quality sports equipment: Matching kits, football boots, balls, and training materials.
- Comprehensive training modules: Football coaching coupled with vital life skills training.
- Administrative support: To promote and foster team development.

But that's not all. We will also nurture the participating players to maximize their life chances. We'll provide career counseling, mentoring, and open avenues for professional players to inspire young girls in our local teams. Through our efforts, we will raise the profile of women's football in Uganda, demonstrating the extraordinary power of sport to change lives and communities.
